

Dangerous events which require reporting by the external entity to the Port safety officer and to the regional supervisor of works

Excerpt from the Accidents and Occupational diseases regulations (Notice concerning dangerous incidents at workplaces), 5711-

- **1.** Splitting of a mechanically-powered grinding stone or grinding disk.
- 2. Splitting of a mechanically-turned flywheel or belt drive pulley.
- 3. Splitting of a tank or mechanically-turned needle.
- 4. Elevator collapse or free-fall.
- 5. Free-fall of the car or platform in an elevator.
- 6. Disconnection of a wire cable, rope or chain used for lifting or lowering of the elevator car or platform.
- **7.** Malfunction of the shut-down switch of the drive mechanism or safety mechanism of the elevator or of its parts.

<u>Note</u>: For items 4 to 7, a lifting machine or lifting device shall be considered to be an elevator - if the motion of the elevator car or platform is guided by a liner or liners.

- 8. Collapse or buckling of a crane.
- 9. Falling of a crane, winch or pulley block.
- **10.** Disconnection of a wire cable, rope or chain used by a crane or which are used for lifting, lowering or transporting a cargo by a crane, winch or pulley block.
- **11.** Malfunction of the shut-down switch of the drive mechanism or safety mechanism of the crane, winch or wheel of its parts.
- 12. Explosion or bursting of a gas collector containing gas pressurized to above the atmospheric pressure. For this section, "gas" includes air and steam and a mixture of various gases and also fluids or solids formed by gas compession.
- 13. Explosion of a steam boiler and any damage to the steam boiler structure caused by fire re-emission. For this section, a "steam boiler" means - a sealed vessel in which steam forms for any purpose at a pressure greater than the atmospheric pressure, including any economizer used for heating the water delivered to the steam boiler and also any superheater used for heating steam.
- **14.** Explosion or fire which have damaged a building, machines, installations, electrical appliances, or electricity lines.
- **15.** Collapse of a scaffold intended for construction works or engineering construction as per their meaning in the Work Safety Ordinance 1946, with the exception of a scaffold from where there is no falling hazard from it or from any of its parts to a depth of more than 2 meters.
- 16. Collapse of formwork used for pouring concrete, at a height of more than 2 meters, and which is intended for construction or engineering construction works as per their meaning in the Work Safety Ordinance 1946.
